Upshaw Internet Resources

(By Tom Upshaw, 10 Windsor Ct., Somerset, NJ 08873-4951, April 2000)

A couple years ago, I discovered the power of Internet genealogy and set up a web page at <http://www.upshaw.org/familytree/> as a home base for Upshaw descendants and genealogists researching the Upshaw and related families. While my time schedule has been rather tight recently, I continue to gradually add new resources and update the page with new information. The page also contains an index of Upshaw family researchers and an online family tree of all known Upshaw descendants (excluding those who may still be living). In the near future I plan to add a photo/image gallery for old Upshaw-related family pictures, photos of locations of historic value, and photo reproductions of original documents.

In this short article, I simply want to summarize some of the Internet resources available to those researching the Upshaws and invite you to visit the web page for future updates.

The Internet has been a breakthrough for the sharing of genealogy information, before only accessible through extensive travel, painstaking correspondence and significant cost for materials and duplication. Now that much of this information is being disseminated widely, one can only hope that house fires, war, natural disasters and the apathy of uninterested family members who "threw out" most of the old family records will no longer be such an insurmountable barrier to further progress in tracing the branches of our family trees, since duplication and archiving of the records in multiple locations will be much more common. The main difficulty will lie in verifying the reliability of our online sources of information and certifying their connection back to primary sources.

1. MAILING LISTS

Even with just an e-mail account, one can connect with other Upshaw researchers all over the world to share information by means of the UPSHAW-L mailing list. This is an automated mailing list where messages sent to the list are distributed to all the subscribers. The various list subscribers collectively possess information to connect nearly every Upshaw in North America, or at least those born before 1900.

Simply send an e-mail message with the text "subscribe" (no quotes) to UPSHAW-L-REQUEST@rootsweb.com, and you will begin receiving the messages. To send messages to the list, simply reply to list messages or send them to: UPSHAW-L@rootsweb.com. The list is also available for discussion of possible connections to families with alternate spellings such as Upshur, Upsher, Upcher, Upshar, Upshire, Upshot and Upshall, plus possibly-related names such as Apshaw, Abshawe, Upchurch. Some of these names also have their own genealogy mailing lists; thousands of such lists are hosted by the www.rootsweb.com genealogy site, which is a good starting point for researching any family or genealogy topic. Mailing lists also exist for particular regions, towns and counties.

2. GENFORUM: <http://www.genforum.com/upshaw/>

A particularly active online message board where information is posted and exchanged by surname is GenForum. The above address is for the Upshaw forum there.

3. GENCONNECT: <http://cgi.rootsweb.com/~genbbs/genbbs.cgi/surnames/ups/Upshaw>

GenConnect is another online message board which is more extensive in design, but so far has seen less information "accumulate" in its pages. GenConnect is hosted at the rootsweb site and divides each surname into several message boards, each with a specific purpose such as queries, wills, obituaries, deeds, and bible entries.

"The story of the Upshaw family of Dickenson County, Kansas" written by Mrs. Lina Upshaw Stanbaugh, second daughter of Francis Marion Upshaw.

The sun was setting in the golden glow behind the tops of the Ozarks and all nature was doing her best to proclaim peace to the people of a nation at war with itself. In the door of a quiet little house on the outskirts of the town of Marshfield, Mo., perched on the top of the highest of these miniature mountains, stood a young woman, anxiously waiting for the return of her young and hot headed husband. Many evenings had she watched with the same anxiety for his homecoming from the mill during these turbulent times, when the tie of blood stood as naught on the break between the North and the South.

Francis Marion Upshaw was an ardent Union man, in a land where all were loudly proclaiming their allegiance to the cause of the Confederacy. His uncle, Dr. John Upshaw, a man of influence and wealth, had begged him to be more politic but his loyalty to his country and his ardor for its safety impelled him to proclaim it at every opportunity. Twice before he had been threatened with lynching and now tonight, he must take home to his waiting wife the last ultimatum. They would give him from sunset to sunrise to get to a place of safety. Before his eyes as he prepared his little family for the journey, they set fire to his house and as it burned, lit the way for them as they sadly moved out through the deep forest to seek shelter in the camp of Union ("Tom Selgh's" lined out) army, 20 miles away.

The trials and privations, which this little band passed through, were experienced by many others who were caught at this time south of the Mason and Dixon line. This was in the spring of '61. The war was fought and won by the government and in the spring of 1867, the father started with his family, to find a home to take the place of the one he had lost.

Kansas had been opened to homestead and all loyal men were entitled to 80 acres of this land. If they had served on the Union side, they were entitled to 160 acres, but as he had been crippled in his right hand in the mill at Marshfield he did not serve. Two brothers whom he brought north with him, George and Thomas Upshaw, did serve. Thomas was fifteen and George seventeen when they enlisted. They served through the entire five years. Thomas enlisting for the last sixty days call.

All three went to Dickinson County, Kansas at this early day and lived the life incident to the pioneer at this time. But none of the privations through which they passed could compare with the fear and terror and oftentimes thirst and starvation as they traveled northward seeking shelter in a war-ridden land.

In June 1867 at 10 o'clock on a dark night with the rain pouring as it had for a month or more with no indication that it would ever stop, the party arrived at Abilene, Dickinson Co., Kansas and inquired at the only house in the town which was destined to become the wildest town of what is known as the time of the Texas trade. Each of the party took up a claim, lived on it and took their part in the pioneer life which was necessary to make of Kansas the great state she has become.

Thomas J. Upshaw became a doctor as his father had been. George W. Upshaw who was of an artistic turn became a painter for a livelihood but his greatest pleasure was in getting all the children around him and paint for them out of his imagination pictures that would have done credit to an art exhibit. The walls of our home were hung with many a gem. Francis M. Upshaw farmed on his 80 acres and prospered to some extent. Then he and F. (?) C. Henry bought Texas cattle to winter and then sell for beef. One winter they all died, then he bought more land and turned to wheat. In the meantime he and M. Nicol built most of the houses in Abilene in the early days and the Hoffman mill at Enterprise, Dickinson Co.

The second year after the arrival of these immigrants in 1869 another band composed of Edmond Keller, John Reves and others came. They stayed with the Upshaws until settled in their own homes. The older settlers sharing with the new, unselfishly.

In 1879 Francis M. Upshaw sold all lands and went into the furniture and undertaking business in Abilene. His wife, Juliette B. Upshaw, having died the year previous, leaving five children, Virginia, William, Lina G., Ida May and George S. In the years that followed, prosperity blessed his every effort. His children, all but one, married and settled about him. His youngest daughter, Ida M., took her mother's place and remained single and became his homemaker and companion.

The Upshaws were of French descent, natives of Tennessee, ancestors came over with Lafayette to fight in the Revolution. (Editor's note: this closing statement is inaccurate, as Capt. William Upshaw is documented as early as 1697 and he died in 1720, nearly sixty years before the American Revolution).
